A Green Roof is a vegetated roof cover that is installed on top of an otherwise conventional roof, giving the roof characteristics that more closely resemble a natural environment. It offers numerous highly beneficial and cost-saving functions, including stormwater runoff reduction, heating and cooling load reduction, and extending the service life of the roof by 40 to 60 years.
